### Topics

Our topics for this term are Nursery and Other Rhymes, Holidays and Journeys. During this half term, we will be learning different rhymes and stories. We will talk about story structure, and we will listen out for the rhyming words. After the half term holiday, we will be talking about going on holiday and the things they will do and see when they are there. We will also talk about different ways of getting to different places. During this term, we are learning about different celebrations: St. George's Day, Eid and Father's Day.

### At Home

As we did last year, we will be sending home reading books with children who are 3 and 4 years old. These books **MUST** be brought back into school every day with their reading records so we can practise with the children in school as often as we can. This book will not be changed until the children are confident with these sounds. Can I also please remind you that we practise the letter sounds abc, as opposed to the letter names ABC. This was highlighted at the Reading Evening, and in your child's Induction Pack.
