Topics

Our topics for this term are Traditional Tales and Transport. During this half term, we will be learning about different traditional tales and will be thinking about story structure and characters. After the half term holidays we will be looking at different types of transport; what kinds of transport we use every day and other types of transport that take us to exciting places. During this term, we will also be learning about different celebrations: Easter, St Georges Day, Father's Day and Eid.

At Home

Homework is now being sent home for Pre-school children only. Can I ask that this be completed and brought back into school with your child's name on it. As we did last term, we will be sending home reading books with children who are 3 and 4 years old. These books **MUST** be brought back into school every day with their **reading records** so that we can practise with the children in school as often as we can. This book will **not** be changed until the children are confident with these sounds, but as they get more confident they will also take home sound cards. Can I also please remind you that we practise the letter sounds abc as opposed to the letter names ABC, as some of the children are still making this mistake. Also when reading with your children at home please encourage them to describe the story and pictures, and when you are out and about, talk about the different transportation you can see and talk about where you think it might be going.
