

Testing for students after the holiday period

As all parents should be aware, we have been asked that all secondary school students undertake one on-site test, on return in January. This will be carried out on Monday 10th January. This will help boost testing participation and reduce transmission after a period of social mixing during the holidays. Students should then be strongly encouraged to continue testing twice weekly

1. at school. The attached slip will need to be returned. Parents who have returned the slip already need not complete it again.
2. at home and to [report all results to NHS Test and Trace](#) and to the school.

Even if someone has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 90 days, they are strongly encouraged to take part in LFD testing on-site through ATS or at home once they have completed their isolation period for their prior infection.
